Cookies

The Krakenrealtime website uses cookies. Cookies are small text files that are placed on the hard disk of your computer or mobile device when you visit our website. Cookies contain information for instance about your preferences and about how you use our website, and they allow your browser to be recognised on a subsequent visit to our website. In this cookie statement, we explain which cookies are stored and for what purposes.

Functional - cookies to ensure that the Krakenrealtime website functions properly

We use cookies to help our website work properly. These are functional cookies that are only used for this specific purpose. We use cookies for example to make navigating and logging in on the Krakenrealtime website easier, and/or to remember your preferences when using the Krakenrealtime website. For example, you then do not have to enter your login data every time on our website. For the sake of clarity, we would like to point out that functional cookies are always stored, irrespective of the choices you make. Such cookies may be stored without permission.

Statistics/analysis - Cookies that let us measure how the Krakenrealtime website is used

To determine which parts of the website are most interesting for our visitors, we always try to measure how many visitors come to our website and which parts are viewed most often. We use cookies for this. We may for example keep track of how many visitors go to a particular web page or click a particular advert, so that Krakenrealtime knows which parts of its website are popular. This will let us make the structure, navigation and content of the website as user-friendly as possible for you. We attempt to make this data as anonymous as possible. Google Analytics A cookie is stored through our website by Google, as part of the Google Analytics service provided by that company. Krakenrealtime uses this service to keep track of how visitors use the website and to generate reports about that usage. Google may

provide that information to third parties if legally required to do so, or insofar as third parties process that information on behalf of Google. Krakenrealtime has no control over this.

Advertisements - Cookies for showing adverts

These cookies are used for matching up advertisements to your interests and to prevent the same adverts from being shown multiple times.

Social media - Cookies for sharing the content of our website through social media

Our website includes buttons for promoting and sharing web pages on social networks, namely Facebook, YouTube, Weibo, Twitter, Instagram and Naver. In order to let these buttons work, we use social media cookies from these social media providers. For details of the cookies that these social media providers store and the data that they may potentially collect through them, please refer to the statements issued by those parties about this on their own websites. Note: those declarations may be changed regularly. We have no control over this.

How to change the cookie settings

The browser settings on your computer let you delete cookies that have already been stored and refuse to allow new cookies to be stored. The method for doing this varies from one browser to the next. If necessary, please consult the help function of your browser. Note: if you refuse cookies and/or delete them, you may not always be able to make full use of the capabilities of the website. In addition, rejecting or deleting cookies only affects the combination of computer and browser for which you perform that action. If you use multiple computers and/or browsers, you should repeat the above-mentioned actions as often as necessary.

Right to inspect and correct or delete your data

You have the right to ask to see and correct or delete your data. Please refer to our contact page for details. To prevent misuse, we may then ask you to provide appropriate identification. Where this request refers to inspecting personal data associated with a cookie,

you should also send a copy of the cookie in question. The settings for your browser will tell you where to find it.
